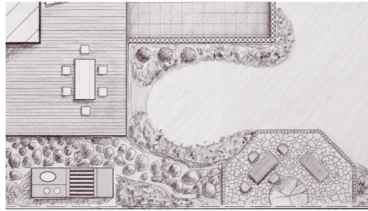


Learn about the benefits to creating a comprehensive design for a home landscape.

Learn from experts the practices and principles of what goes into a landscape design.

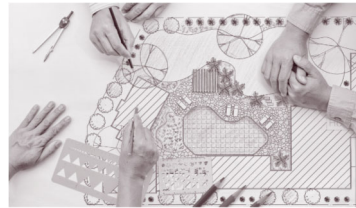
Learn how to make different types of landscape drawings that are useful in the design process.
